## Seeking produce and photographs: Show us your talents

The NSW Farmers' Association is reminding Members that only days remain for entries in the Association's Regional Food Fair and Annual Conference photography competition.

NSW Farmers' Association President Jock Laurie says that Members growing the best lamb, beef and goat meat or olives, herbs and quail are encouraged to submit their produce to Regional Food Fair, with entries for produce closing this Friday 3 July.

"The event is expected to attract 500 guests, all of whom are looking to sample gourmet delights featuring local food," Mr Laurie said.

"As a farmer, this is the perfect opportunity to get your product on the plates in front of your most important audience: future customers.

"Menu items include lamb cutlets with mint, smoked duck breast with chestnut brulee and duck crackling, and seared beef fillet, shaved truffle and thyme shortbread.

"So if you'd like your produce to be part of the innovative and exciting Regional Food Fair menu, we want to hear from you today," Mr Laurie said.

Mr Laurie also reminded Members that entries for the Annual Conference photography competition close next Friday 10 July.

"We are searching for the most outstanding photographs of life on the land to display at Annual Conference, with a 'Colours of the Bush' theme," Mr Laurie said.

"All Members are encouraged to submit their images of country life, be it rural produce, people or places.

"This imagery will be a wonderful public demonstration of who we are and what we do, and I urge you to get involved," Mr Laurie said.

Regional Food Fair will take place on Tuesday 28 July as part of the Association's Annual Conference. Photographs entered in the photography competition will be on display at Annual Conference with the winner awarded a \$500 RM Williams gift voucher.
