## President to visit Goulburn Crookwell

The NSW Farmers' Association President Charles Armstrong will tour the Goulburn and Crookwell regions later this month, meeting with local Members to discuss issues such as property rights and local industries.

The President will stop for lunch with Members and other locals in Goulburn, and dinner in Crookwell on Monday 29 March 2010

"This region has obviously faced adversity and challenges specifically regarding the drought, as many areas have," Charles Armstrong said.

"Given the large wool industry in this area, I expect to discuss other issues such as animal health, research and development and industry representation," he said.

"Another issue affecting farmers and indeed all landholders around the country is of course the erosion of property rights, and this is certainly the case for people in the Southern Highlands.

"I look forward to hearing more about these issues from our Members, and being able to share information about where the Association is up to in our lobbying activities."
