Tertiary Scholarship applications due in soon

The deadline for all NSW Farmers' Association Tertiary Scholarship applications is fast approaching, with three weeks to go until applications close.

NSW Farmers' Association Tertiary Scholarship Selection Panel Chair Sarah Thompson says entries close on Friday 10 February.

"The Association has been offering these scholarships to university students since 1993," Ms Thompson said.

"Eight scholarships valued at \$5,000 each are on offer to students who are committed to helping our farming and rural communities grow and develop into the future," Ms Thompson said.

Students must be in their second year of university study, or first or second year of vocational study to be eligible

In addition, students; their partners; or their parents must have held a Full Producer Membership with the Association over the past two years.

"The Association is keen to reward students who show an enthusiasm and passion for agriculture, to help them become future industry leaders," Ms Thompson said.

"I would encourage all eligible students to begin the application process now, to avoid missing out on this great opportunity," Sarah Thompson said.
