NSW Farmers' Association runs a program of talks and events at the Young Farmers' Forum every year during Annual Conference. The Young Farmers' Committee put forward motions at the Conference as the representative of rural youth.

In 2008 the following motions were carried:

Regional Funding (Amended)

That the Association lobby the appropriate authority to reassess the off farm income criteria for the interest rate subsidies to assist young farmers in establishing new business ventures.

Young Farmer Finance

That the association lobbies the New South Wales State Government to obtain a program similar to the Victorian Governments Young Farmer's Finance Scheme.

Student Allowances (Amended)

That Rural Affairs Committee and Young Farmers Committee work together to develop a more equitable system of assistance to include the effect on HECS HELP and FEE HELP repayments and withdrawal rates on AUSTUDY.

And, this motion was referred to the Rural Affairs Committee:

Young Farmer Finance

That the Association lobby the Federal Government to introduce a program similar to the current 'First Home Buyers Grant' to be known as the 'First Farm Buyers Grant' that includes:

- (a) No stamp duty; and
- (b) Reduced interest rates.

Industrial Relations and OH&S are constantly changing areas, so it is important to be up-to-date with legislation. Our practical on-farm strategies are specifically designed for students - the next generation.

Topics explored through case studies are based on real-life examples the Association has had to deal with over the years, with a focus on making the participants aware of relevant industrial relations issues.

The first workshop involved a hands-on approach, with approximately 120 first and second year agricultural and rural science students participating in an on-farm occupational health and safety workshop.

Students were again encouraged to think practically about solutions to common problems on-farm, using examples based on Member queries and experiences.
