Become part of a collective voice for country NSW – join at Henty!

The NSW Farmers' Association is putting the call out to all farmers to take part in the Henty Machinery Field Days, and take advantage of membership deals on offer.

NSW Farmers' Association President Charles Armstrong will take part in the event over the next three days.

"With the State election looming it's important to keep in touch with members on the ground, to listen to their concerns first hand," Mr Armstrong said.

"I also want to meet with farmers who aren't current members of the Association, who don't know about the role we play in lobbying for rural and regional NSW.
