Fair Work Act Seminar in Young

The NSW Farmers' Association will present a workshop in Young next Tuesday, outlining major changes to industrial relations laws.

The seminar will outline new workplace laws that came into effect on 1 July this year, and others to commence from 1 January 2010 which affect the day-to-day interaction of employers and employees.

It will be run by experienced agricultural workplace relations advisors who will explain in detail unfair dismissal laws, the National Employment Standards (NES) Modern Awards, new enterprise bargaining arrangements and the impacts of a referral of industrial relations powers by the State.

There will also be opportunity for one-on-one advice on how the new laws will apply to farmers and their employees.
