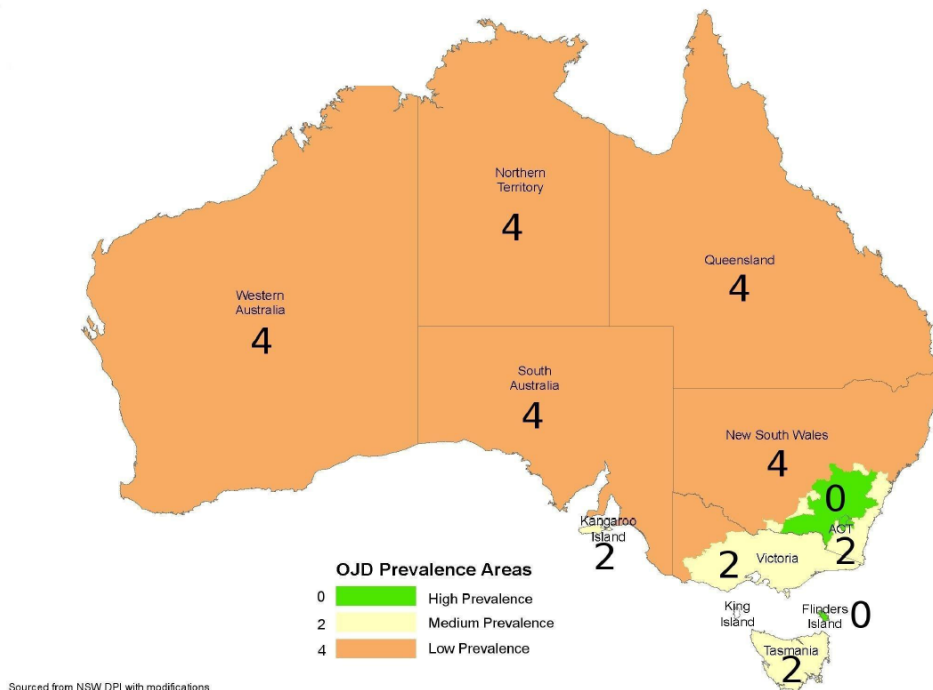


Ovine Johnes Disease Prevalence Areas

- Under the new OJD National Management Plan that will come into effect from 31 March 2008 there will be 3 prevalence areas in NSW.
- The map below shows roughly where the new prevalence zones will be.
 - the current High and Medium Prevalence Zones have been incorporated into the new High Zone,
 - the Low Prevalence Zone has become the new Medium Zone and
 - the Very Low Prevalence Zone has become the Low Zone.
- The exact boundaries will be set by the NSW Department of Primary Industries early in 2008.
