Media Alert: Executive Council comes to the Country Music Capital

The NSW Farmers' Association Executive Council will be rolling into Tamworth next week to discuss the big issues facing agriculture, including drought, quarantine, NLIS, wheat marketing and mining.

The Council, a seventy-strong body that represents Association Members, will be in Tamworth for its first quarterly meeting for the year on Tuesday 3 and Wednesday 4 March.

NSW Farmers' Association President Jock Laurie's opening address in Tamworth is expected to cover changes that have occurred during his four-year Presidency, major issues the Association has addressed and what will be facing agriculture in the future.

In addition to debating and determining policy, Councillors will also undertake a tour hosted by the Caroon Coal Action Group, hear from guest speaker Andrew Jackson of Country Fresh Australasia and be entertained by bush poet Paddy Ryan.

Local Members are invited to attend the meeting, with a session in the agenda specifically for Members to raise important issues with the elected officials. This session is scheduled for 4pm on Tuesday 3 March and the Association is encouraging all local Members to attend.
