## **Pork producers to support Homeless Connect Project**

NSW pork producers will support next week's *Sydney Homeless Connect* project to be held at Sydney Town Hall.

An initiative of The Council of Capital City Lord Mayors, this is the first time the project has been held in Sydney and NSW Farmers' Association Pork Committee Chair Mal Gett says pork producers are pleased to be able to be involved.

"By being involved, pork producers are showing that they support this project to help people less fortunate find a new path in their lives," Mal Gett said

"Amongst other things, next week's project aims to provide food to feed approximately 2000 homeless people," Mr Gett said.

Mr Gett says pork producers from around NSW will supply around 500 kilograms of boned rolled string tied pork shoulders.

"People attending the event will be offered a roast meat meal, compliments of the Association's Pork Committee, as opposed to a normal offering of soup," Mr Gett said.

"They will also have access to barbers, doctors, dentist, housing agents and so on," Mr Gett said.

The Sydney Homeless Connect project aims to help the less fortunate take the first steps on a path out of homelessness. Organisers say they want to give these people a day where they can feel respected and loved.

Representatives of the NSW Farmers' Association Pork Committee will attend the event next Tuesday 8 June, commencing at 10am.
