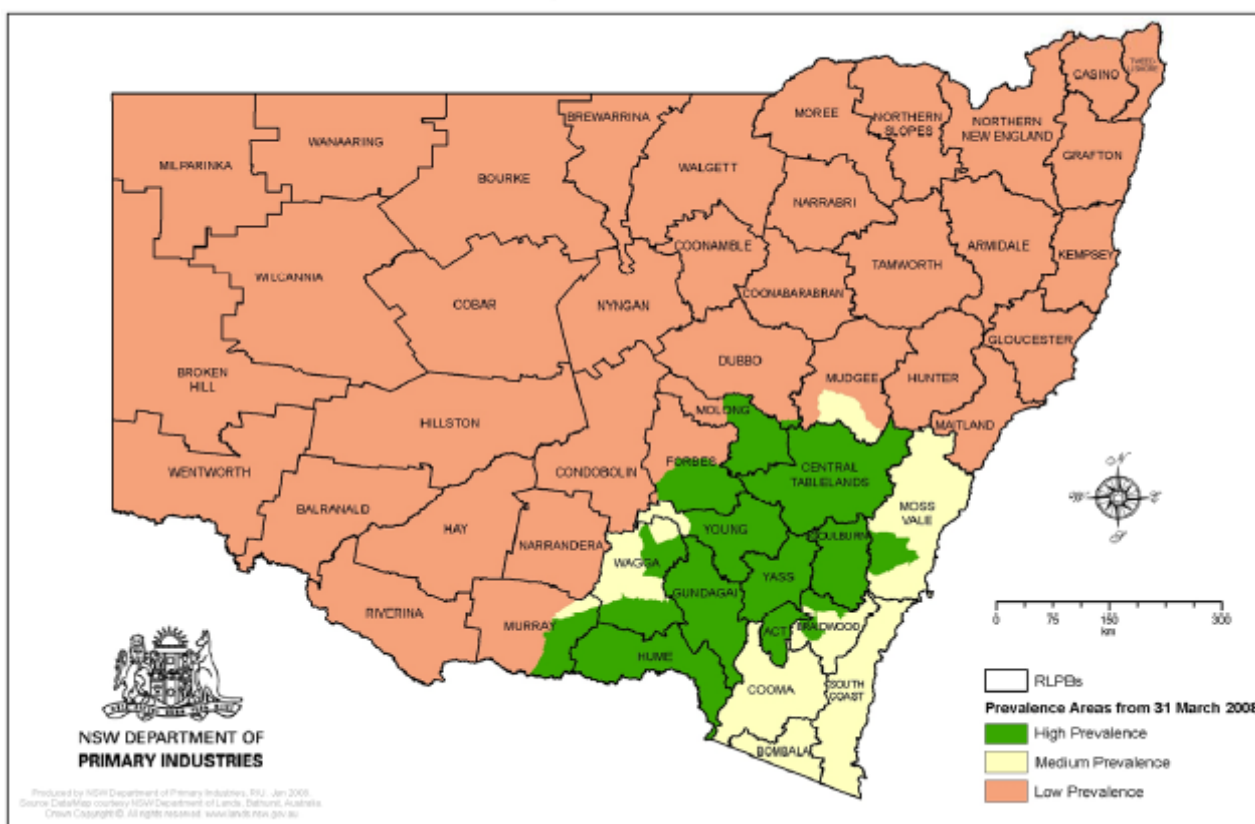


Ovine Johnes Disease Prevalence Areas

- Under the new National OJD National Management Plan that will come into effect from 31 March 2008 the old 4 Prevalence Area model will be replaced with a 3 Prevalence Area nation wide model.
- The map below shows where the new prevalence zones will be.
 - the current High and Medium Prevalence Zones have been incorporated into the new High Zone,
 - the Low Prevalence Zone has become the new Medium Zone and
 - the Very Low Prevalence Zone has become the Low Zone.

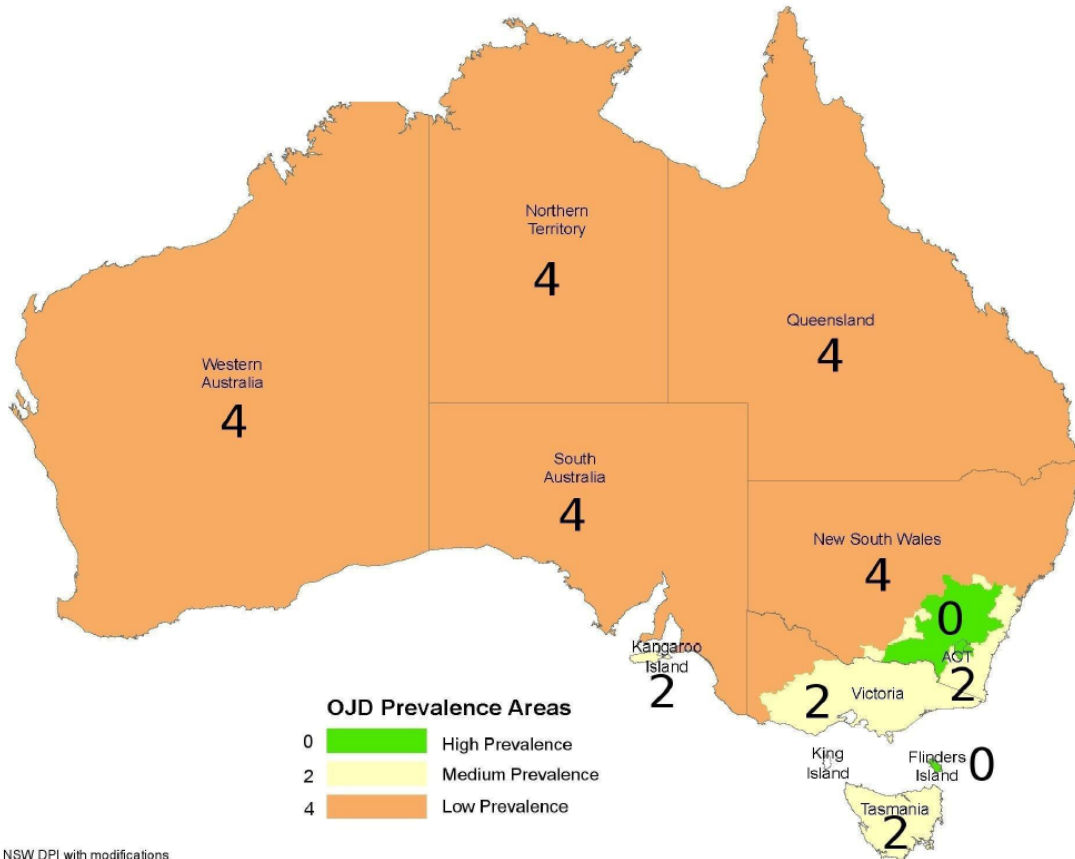
NSW OJD Prevalence Area for Implementation from 31 March 2008

NEW Prevalence Area from 31 March 2008	Maximum Estimated Flock Prevalence	New points
Low Prevalence	0.8%	4
Medium Prevalence	12.5%	2
High Prevalence	-	0
