

Q9. CattleMAP

CattleMAP is the Australian Johnes Disease Market Assurance Program for Cattle.

CattleMAP is a voluntary quality assurance program which enables producers to objectively assess, maintain and promote the low risk BJD status of their herd to their clients. CattleMAP herds provide the highest available assurance of a herds low risk status for BJD.

Herds enrolled in the CattleMAP have to implement a simple biosecurity plan and be regularly tested to demonstrate that they are not infected. To protect the status of the herd they also have to follow rules on introductions, agistment and movement

Cattle MAP scores of MN₁, MN₂, MN₃ are equivalent to dairy scores 8,9,10
