Join the Rally bus: Northern NSW to Canberra

The momentum in Northern NSW is building with five buses already heading to Canberra for a Property Rights Rally on 2 February 2010.

A Tamworth bus will collect participants from Gunnedah, Mullaley, Tambar Springs and Coolah; the Inverell bus will stop in Moree; and a Coonabarabran bus will pick up Mendooran locals. There will also be a bus travelling from Toowoomba, and possibly Tenterfield.

Meanwhile, a minibus will leave Pilliga and travel via Gwabegar to Canberra and a Walgett bus is filling up quickly.

Further transport will be coordinated in accordance with demand, but as services are filling up quickly those interested should contact the Association ASAP.
