MEDIA ALERT – BEEF SPECTACULAR

The NSW Farmers' Association is teaming up with the Cattle Council of Australia to host a producer focused seminar at the NSW Beef Spectacular in Dubbo.

Hamish Munro, mixed farming producer from Cumnock, Member of the NSW Farmers' Association Cattle Committee and the Cattle Council, will talk to producers about the environmental accreditation and offer opportunities for questions and feedback.

The Cattle Council is exploring options for a voluntary environmental accreditation for beef producers that aims to acknowledge sustainable land management practices on-farm.

Producers will also hear from NSW Farmers' Association Cattle Committee Members and Cattle Council Councilors on current beef issues and learn about the relationship between the two organisations.

There will be a practical demonstration on how producers can download electronic National Vendor Declarations forms and how to update property-to-property transfers.

The NSW Farmers' Association will be running a competition throughout Beef Spectacular for producers to go in the running to win a pair of RM Williams boots if they visit the NSW Farmers' Association Stand before 2pm Saturday 6 March 2010.
