Media Alert: President's visit to Mid-North Coast

The NSW Farmers' Association President Jock Laurie will conduct a visit to the Mid-North Coast this week to meet with local Members and discuss the damage caused by the recent North Coast floods.

The visit, which will take place on Thursday 14 May, will update the President on the issues affecting the region, particularly the damage caused to the local oyster industry as a result of the floods, and the recent changes to Livestock Health and Pest Authority rates.
