Horticulture Industry Seminars

The NSW Farmers' Association will present a series of seminars in April and May outlining major changes to industrial relations laws with a focus on the Horticulture Industry

The seminars will run similar to the Fair Work Seminars recently held by the Association and aim to inform members of the major changes to workplace laws and the Modern Award, the *Horticulture Award 2010* which took effect from the 1 January this year.

The seminars will be run by experienced agricultural workplace relations advisors who will also present detailed information on the National Employment Standards (NES), transitional arrangements and options members have with regards to Individual Flexibility Arrangements (IFAs).

This will also be a prime opportunity for one-on-one advice and discussion on how horticulture producers' businesses may be affected.
